RULES FOR BASKETBALL GALA DAY

- Unlimited substitutions may be made at any time.
- No cross court rule (ball may be passed back over half way).
- No 3 second rule.
- No foul counts however referees may sit a player off if they are continually fouling.
- First pass after a goal is to be **uncontested**.
- Referees will be told to pull up blatant travelling, double dribbling and fouls but to generally let play go and explain to students what they should be doing, especially with the juniors. They will be told to be stricter with seniors especially with fouls.
- No scoring will be kept.
- Times will run off a central buzzer. Straight 20 minute games. No half time.
- 2 minutes between games.
- All teams are encouraged to make sure that all players have equal game time.
- Please remind students and especially parents it is a gala day for fun, bad sportsmanship will not be tolerated.
- Size 5 ball will be used.

Students from St Paul's International College and Moss Vale High School will be referee on the day.
